## PHARMACY ASSISTANT FRONT-END

Program graduates will be able to provide efficient and effective support to pharmacists and pharmacy technicians by maintaining electronic patient health records and performing administrative duties like answering phones and inventorying pharmacy stock and supplies.

# PHARMACY TECHNICIAN PROFESSIONAL

This program contains approximately 350 hours of content delivered by engaging and interactive learning materials, like simulations and virtual exercises. Students will also receive a complete lab kit to allow them to perform hands-on practical labs remotely. Upon completion of the course content, students are required to complete a 160-hour externship with an outside pharmacy and sit for the PTCE certification exam, the cost of which is included in the program. In addition to the certification exam, the program is ASHP accredited, which is an educational requirement of some state boards and employers. Students can begin the program at age 17 but must be 18 and obtain clearances before starting their externship.

# **MEDICAL ASSISTANT**

This program aligns and prepares graduates for several industry certification exams by utilizing a learning platform that provides engaging, interactive learning materials including numerous simulations and virtual exercises. Students will perform hands-on Practical Labs virtually and recieve complete lab kit of items needed. This will requires 160 hour externship and includes cost for graduates to sit for the NHA CCMA certification exam. Students can begin the program at age 17, however they must be 18 years old to begin their externship. This program will require students to obtain clearances for their externship.

# STERILE PROCESSING TECHNICIAN

In this program, students will be given an overview of allied health careers and healthcare laws and regulations at both state and federal levels. Students will be introduced to topics like medical terminology, microbiology, disease-causing pathogens, and sterile processing technology in medical settings. This program prepares students to sit for the Certified Registered Central Service Technician (CRCST) exam offered by the International Association of Healthcare Central Service Material Management (IAHCSMM). In addition to the exam, students are required to obtain 400-hours of hands-on experience in a sterile processing department. Students can begin the program at age 17 but must be 18 and obtain clearances before starting their hands-on experience.
